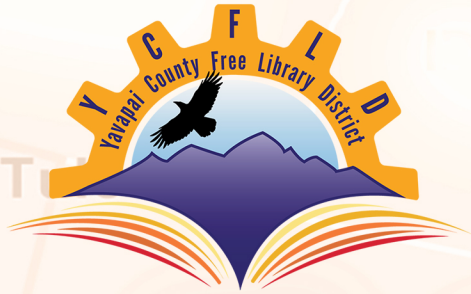

## The Internment Experience

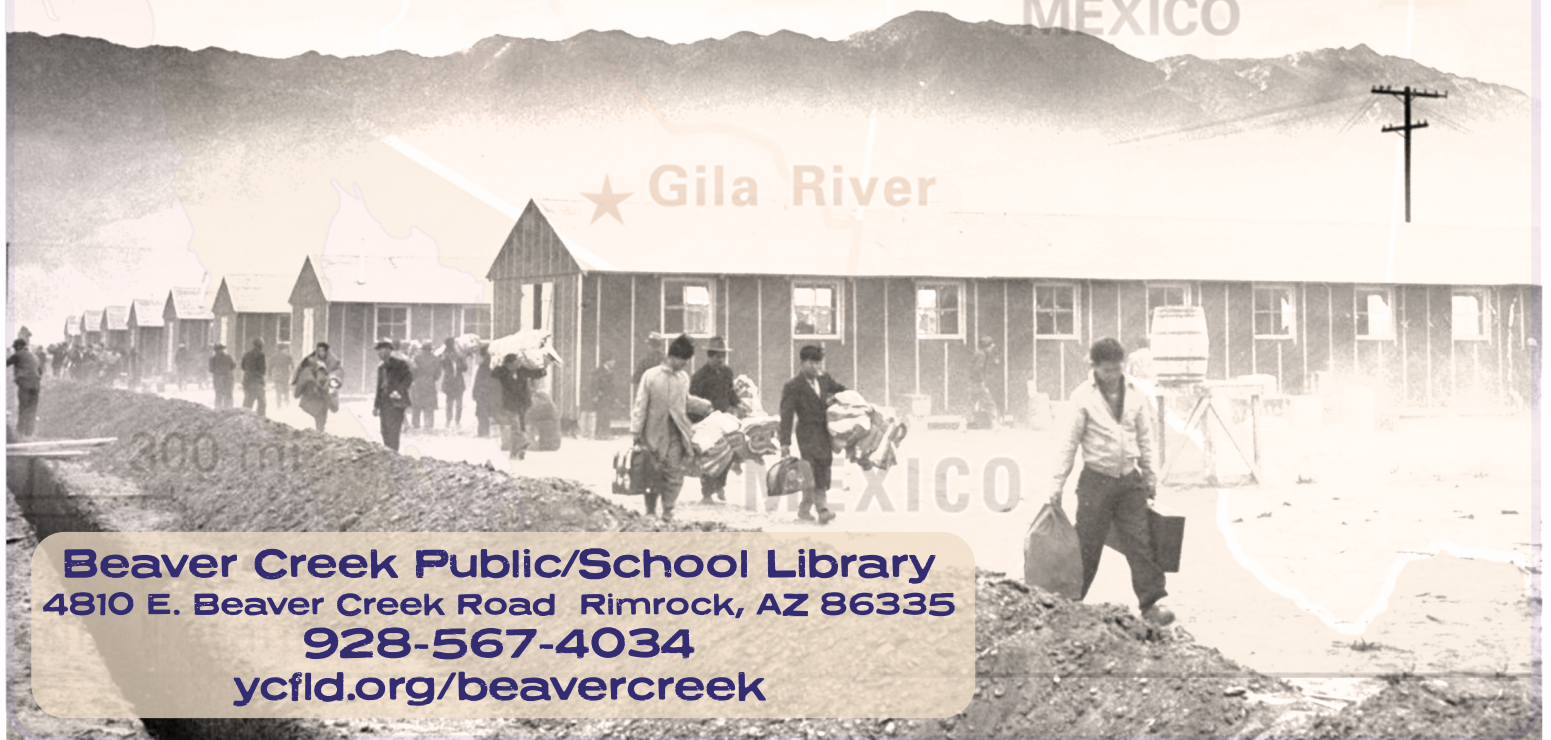
Thursday, January 20th 3-5pm
